Winter League 2005 will begin on Wednesday, January 5th at 6:00 pm. The league will consist of 300 birds (12 rounds). We will be having the bye week once again this year (February 16th thru the 20th). League will end on Sunday, April 3rd at 6:00 pm. Sign up sheets are posted on the bulletin board.

Cost for the leagues will be as follows for Trap & Skeet: Charter \$54 and Associate \$60 per event. Sporting Clays: Charter \$66 and Associate \$78. Teams for Trap & Skeet will be 5 person and Sporting Clays will be 3 person. There will not be a Pee Wee league this year and the Sporting Clays league will only be held if there are at least 3 full teams. You must purchase your

punch card for each event that you will be shooting **before** you shoot your first registered round. You may sign up for league anytime before January 30th. You must have 4 registered lines in by January 30th. They can be shot all in one day with no penalty. Beginning February 2nd normal winter league rules will be in effect. Also you must have your membership dues paid by January 30th.

Copies of Winter League rules will be available at the front counter, it is advised that everyone take time to read over them as there were some changes made concerning how far ahead and behind you can shoot.

Banquet will be on Saturday, April 16th and Calcutta on Sunday, April 17th.
